Knitted Basic Rose



STITCHES AND TECHNIQUES

K – Knit

P – Purl

P2tog – Purl 2 together

Pfb – Purl into front and back of stf

Kfb – Knit into front and back of st

K2tog – Knit 2 together

STS (sts) – Stitch(es)

St st – Stockinette stitch

PATTERN

Cast on 5 sts.

Small petals

R1: Kfb, k4. 6 sts.

R2: P4, pfb, p1. 7 sts.

R3: K7.

R4: P7.

R5: K1, k2tog, k4. 6 sts.

R6: P3, p2tog, p1. 5 sts.

Repeat 1st–6th rows 3 times. Do not break yarn.

Medium petals

R1 and 3: Kfb, k to end.

R2 and 4: P to last 2 sts, pfb, p1.

R5 and 7: K9.

R6 and 8: P9.

R9 and 11: K1, k2tog, k to end.

R10 and 12: P to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1. 5 sts.

Repeat 1st–12th rows twice. Do not break yarn.

Large petals

R1, 3 and 5: Kfb, k to end.

R2, 4 and 6: P to last 2 sts, pfb, p1.

R7, 9 and 11: K11.

R8, 10 and 12: P11.

R13, 15 and 17: K1, k2tog, k to end.

R14, 16 and 18: P to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1. 5 sts.

Repeat 1st–18th rows twice. Fasten off.

Finishing

Press. With reverse St st to outside, roll up loosely from the cast-on end.

Lightly stitch the straight edges together to form a flat base, and then push up centre.

Gather and stitch outside edge at base. Turn back petals and steam if necessary.
